Read below and see what God has done!

My meeting went well in **Kampala, Uganda**. We gathered Bishops and Apostles to help them partner on sharing the gospel throughout their region. There was great unity, joy and excitement.





I learned from a Pastor in **Kyaka II**, where we trained in April, that there were 90 churches from 5 of the 11 zones at our training. The size of the churches have doubled in 7 months!

I then flew to Ethiopia where there was social unrest. So, our schedule of training was flipped and reduced. However, we still trained 40 pastors in **Addis Ababa!**

Their testimonies were challenging. These individuals were trying to reform the Ethiopian Orthodox Church to return to Jesus. They are just like Martin Luther in his day. But, the mention of Jesus' name led to their beatings, jail sentences and excommunication. The result is they have started 450 churches in the last 10 years!



At the training these Pastors were challenged to work on their intimacy with Jesus as first love and to faithfully evangelize, make disciples and start churches. They discovered discipleship is not effective in large groups as we saw with Jesus' and the the disciples' crowds. Evangelism happened in large gatherings and the number of disciples was dismal. But, in small groups and one on one, both experienced great disciple making results. Jesus experienced an 82% success rates (11/12 disciples).

The next training was in **Adama, Ethiopia** with a similar group of pastors numbering 70. There had been 72 people killed just a day or two before my arrival, 55 people were killed by stoning. Their greatest prayer need is safety. One pastor described the training, "This is something that we live... it is not just information." That is true discipleship.

In America we talk a good game, but we don't seem to know how to share our faith one on one and make disciples. Perhaps that is why our discipleship record is the same as the large crowds in Jesus' and the early church's day.
